Subject: Amendment to the Building Emergency Evacuation Plan

Two-stage alarm system

This building is now equipped with a two-stage fire alarm system comprised of:

- Stage 1, "Tone" meaning standby await emergency instructions; and
- Stage 2, "Whoop" meaning evacuate immediately.

Principles of evacuation

Do not use the:

- elevator unless authorized by the Fire Chief; and
- main entrance of the building, since this is used by emergency personnel.

Evacuation of the building

Personnel are to follow these procedures upon hearing an alarm over the voice communication system.

Step	Action							
1	Stop work immediately upon hearing an alarm.							
	Note: If you are not at your desk, then go to step 4.							
2	Secure (if possible) all files and materials to prevent fire or							
	water damage.							
3	Do not use emergency or normal telephone lines.							
4	Walk to the nearest stairwell.

		 voice communication system, or 						
		 your Floor Fire Warden. 						
	whoop	1. exit the building immediately; and						
		2. move to the assembly point in the parking
